- 3a. She is not correct; the subordinate clause is <u>Due to the weather</u> because it does not make sense on its own.
- 1b. Example answer: Despite the cold,Jacob still wanted to play in the garden.2b. Example answer: The party was a great success, even though it was a rush
- great success, even though it was a rush to prepare.
- 3b. He is not correct; the subordinate clause is because the teacher was unwell because it does not make sense on its own.
