

School Dinners

School dinners are available every day, and cost £2 per dinner. These are ordered each morning, and can be payed for via ParentPay. You will receive a letter when your child starts school inviting you to join ParentPay.

Our school dinner menus are published in advance on our school website.

Children in Key Stage 2 are not automatically entitled to free school meals the way they are in KS1. If you are entitled to claim, please make sure that you apply for them before September. Even if you do not intend to claim the meals, we are currently given extra funding for children who have this entitlement, so please check if you are eligible!

Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club runs daily from 8.00-8.40am. We have spaces for up to 30 children to attend, and cereal, toast and juice is provided.

Breakfast clubs costs ± 1.50 a day, or ± 5 a week. If you are entitled to free school meals, you are also entitled to attend breakfast club for free.

Children must be registered before attending breakfast club - please let us know at least the day before.
