

## Adjectives

Adjectives are words used to add description to nouns. By using two adjectives followed by a noun, we can write an expanded noun phrase. For example: the dark, mysterious water.

**Choose one of the images below and create a word bank of adjectives to describe it.**

Think about what different things you can see in the image to describe. Can you think of any expanded noun phrases to describe your chosen image?



Bank of adjectives to be created – minimum of 6.

Can include but not limited to: dark, mysterious, bright, unusual, enormous, extravagant, peculiar, calm, tranquil, shadowy, unfamiliar, extraordinary etc.
