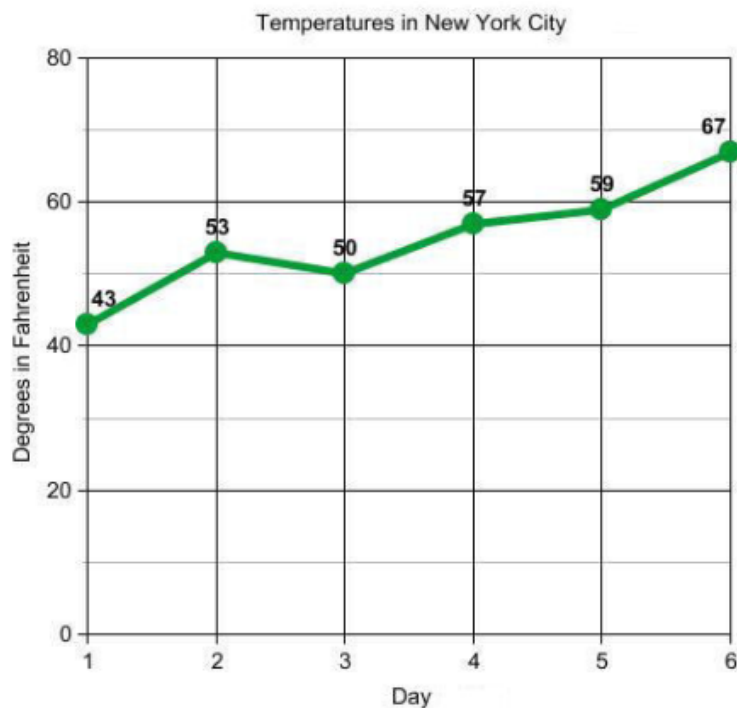


Presenting Data

After we have collected data it is important to use the right type of graph to present it. Remember all graphs need a title and labelled axes.

Line graphs are usually used to show time series data - that is how one or more variables vary over a continuous period of time. Typical examples are monthly rainfall, temperatures and growth rates.



Bar charts are a type of graph that are used to display and compare the number, frequency for different discrete categories of data. There should be clear gaps between the bars of a bar chart.
