Write the instructions for your game. Think about who goes first and what they do. Think about how each turn is played and how you win.

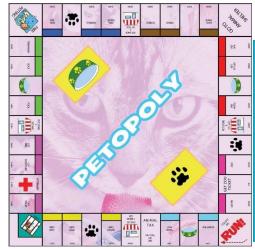
Advertisement
