# Language

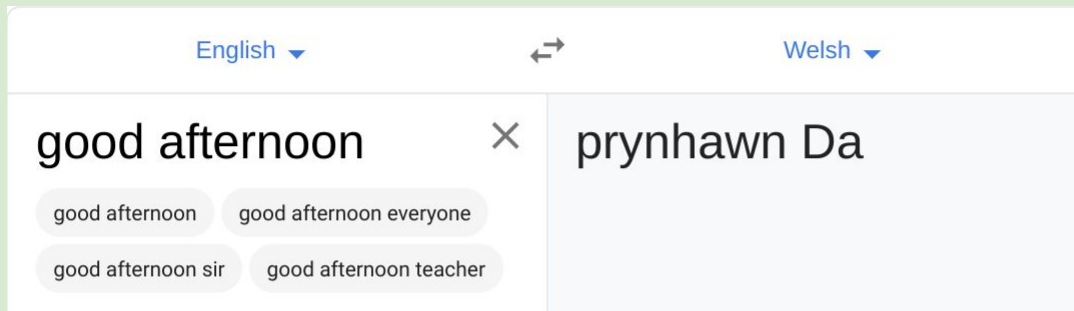
- Around 98% of people speak English.

Can you speak any words in these languages?

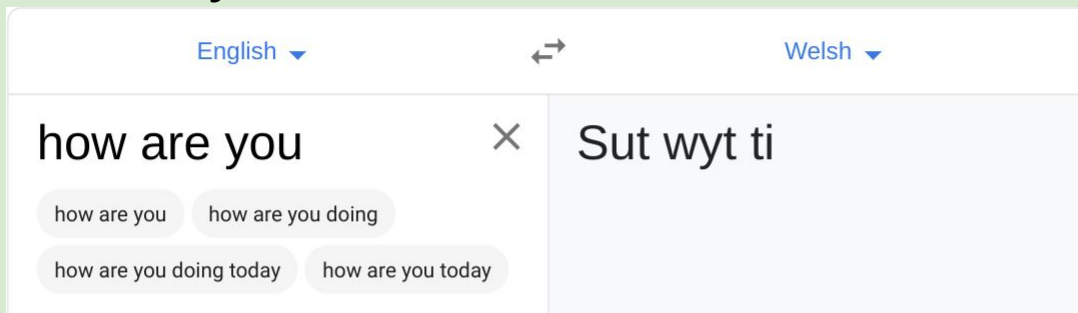

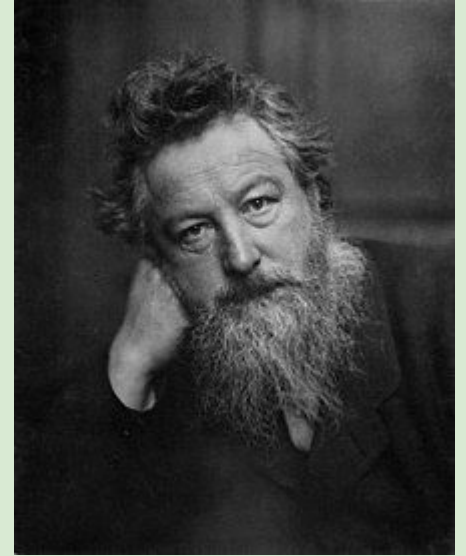

William Morris (24 March 1834 – 3 October 1896) was a British textile designer, poet and novelist associated with the British Arts and Crafts Movement. Morris is recognised as one of the most significant cultural figures of Victorian Britain. He was best known in his lifetime as a poet; after he died he became better known for his floral designs.
