

Summer Week 7 Art Lesson 2

Can I plan a piece of art?

Today we are going to plan the scene outside of our window.



To plan our scene, we need to sketch the outline of what we see outside our window.

Follow these steps to plan your piece and watch the video to help.

Step 1: Choose your view

Decide what view you want to use. Which window is it outside of? Can you see clearly out of it?



Step 2: Find something hard to lean on, a piece of paper and a pencil.

If you have a clipboard at home that's great, but if you don't try to find a hardcover book or something hard enough to lean on.

Find a piece of paper and a pencil too.



Step 3: Sketch the outlines of what you see outside.

Using your pencil and looking out of your window, sketch the outline of what you see.

Remember - **sketching is using your pencil lightly and using short strokes to create lines.**
