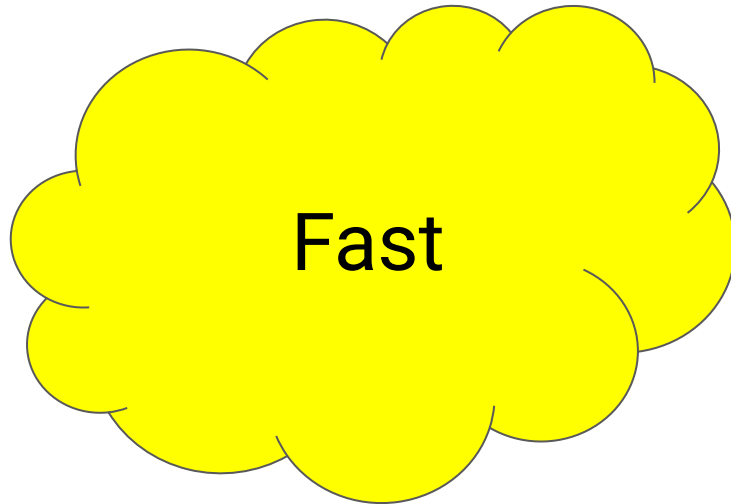

Can I describe a character?

Fast Five

Fast Five - possible answers

Synonyms for the word FAST include:-

Speedy, quick, swifty, rapid, brisk, nimble, high speed

What makes a character description successful?

Ensuring that you:

- Describe the character's appearance (what they look like)
- Describe how the character speaks
- Describe how the character moves
- Describe the character's personality
- Describe the character's actions, thoughts and feelings

Adjectives: Describing words that give more information about the nouns.

Young

Small

Adventurous

Playful

'The young lion cub loved causing mischief.'



Expanded Noun Phrases: A phrase made up of a noun and at least one adjective. (If you use more than one adjective, add a comma between them)

The small, mischievous lion cub

Adjective Adjective Noun

The playful, adventurous lion cub



Similes: The words 'like' or 'as' are used to compare two things.

Simba is as strong **as** an ox.

His nose was as red **as** a rose.

Simba could eat **like** a horse.

He could swim **like** a fish.
