Expanded noun phrase

A phrase that tells you more about the noun. This doesn't just mean using an adjective beforehand.

E.g.

A **small** sheep **with bright blue eyes**.



Bright blue eyes which twinkle in the sunlight.



Long ears that hang down to his shoulders.

Soft, white wool which covers the lamb from head to toe.

Jet-black hooves which click rhythmically against the ground.
