Can I use adverbs?

### **Fast Five Answers**

Last week I ran a marathon.

At ten, I am meeting my friend.

Liam was stronger than her.

The flowers in my garden are pretty because I water them.

Today we are looking at adverbs.

What is an adverb?

An adverb is a word that describes a verb (he sings loudly).

**Adverbs** often end in 'ly', but not all of them do.

For example:

She swims quickly. (Here, the **adverb** quickly modifies the verb swims.)

# Let's look a some examples

### Amanda carefully entered the classroom.

In this sentence the word carefully describes the way in which Amanda entered the classroom.

### David lifted the lid cautiously so as not to disturb the spider.

In this sentence the word cautiously describes how David lifted the lid.
