What is a preposition?

A **preposition** is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else.

For example:

He found the cat underneath the sofa.

'Underneath' is the preposition in this sentence as it shows where the cat was in relation to the sofa.



What is a preposition?

A **preposition** is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else.

For example:

She put the sandwich on the plate.

'On' is the preposition in this sentence as it shows where the sandwich was in relation to the plate.

Prepositions

Conjunctions

A large fin above the machine which keeps it upright and allows it to change direction quickly.

A large door on the side of the machine so explorers can get in easily.

A strong window across the front because the explorers need to see clearly.

An enormous fan on the back so the machine moves forward quickly.

Metal claws in front so it can clear objects carefully.

Small fans which change into wheels and can allow the machine to move on land.
