- 2) Allie mixes 50ml of apple juice with 20ml of strawberry juice. How much juice is in her cup altogether?
- 3) Nia takes a £20 note to the shops. Her shopping costs £12. How much change will she get?
- 4) There was 300g of sugar left in the bag. Max used 200g to bake cookies. How much sugar is left?
- 5) Steve buys a sandwich that costs £1 and 50p and a pack of crisps that costs 25p. How much did his lunch cost altogether?
- 6) If there are 750ml of milk in the bottle and John pours himself a 200ml glass, how much is left in the bottle?

## Yellow Challenge:

- 1) If there are 360g of berries in one punnet and 250g of berries in another, how much is that altogether?
- 2) There is 180ml of water in the measuring jug. 76ml is poured out. How much is left?
- 3) Jenna buys a bunch of bananas for £1 and 32p and a pack of biscuits for £2 and 17p. How much does this cost altogether?
- 4) Alex has a ribbon that is 92cm long. He cuts off 37cm. How much is left?
- 5) Mike's shopping costs £14 and 38p. He pays with a £20 note. How much change will he get?
- 6) There are 320L of water in a paddling pool. At the end of the day, only 282L are left. How much water splashed out of the pool?

## Green Challenge:

- 1) A sloth is 133cm tall. A capybara is 48cm tall. How much taller is the sloth?
- 2) On Monday Alice ran 856m. On Tuesday she ran 448m. How far has she run so far?
- 3) Elise's shopping costs £24 and 17p. She pays with a £20 note and a £10 note. How much change will she get?
- 4) Mr Lee needs to make squash for the football team. He mixes 300ml of syrup with 2L and 400ml of water. How much squash does he have?
- 5) Simon has 778g of flour. He uses 320g for some cupcakes and 115g for some pancakes. How much does he have left?
- 6) Sue buys a watch that costs £9 and 36p and some stickers that cost £3 and 92p. How much will she need to pay?
