




Co-ordinating Conjunctions

These are joining words which can be used to join together two clauses in a sentence.

However, the clauses need to make sense on their own!

Co-ordinating Conjunctions



I had a terrible cold. I still went to school.

These are two separate clauses which alone, make sense. However, a co-ordinating conjunction can be added in the middle...

I had a terrible cold **but** I still went to school.

Here are some examples...

He tried to climb the tree **but** he slipped and fell.

George made a pizza <u>and</u> he put pepperoni on it.
