Examples of facts from the video clip that can be used in their work:

- Christians worship God in many ways.
- In many churches everyone sings together to worship God. In other churches, hymns are sung by a choir.
- Christians believe that God is listening to them sing in church, so they must sing their very best.
- Worship hymns can be traditional and rehearsed, or upbeat and spontaneous.
- Worship through music because it is an easy way to interact with God and it's a way to say 'thank you' and 'please help me'.
- Some say it is like talking to a friend; the conversations can be happy or sad.
- Slower songs make you really think about what you're worshipping about.
- Members of the church believe that God appreciates it when they sing, as it shows that they are grateful for everything that he has done for them during the week.
