What is a preposition?

A **preposition** is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else.

For example:

He found the cat underneath the sofa.

'Underneath' is the preposition in this sentence as it shows where the cat was in relation to the sofa.



What is a preposition?

A **preposition** is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else.

For example:

She from him **behind** the curtain.

'Behind' is the preposition in this sentence as it shows where the girl is in relation to the curtain.

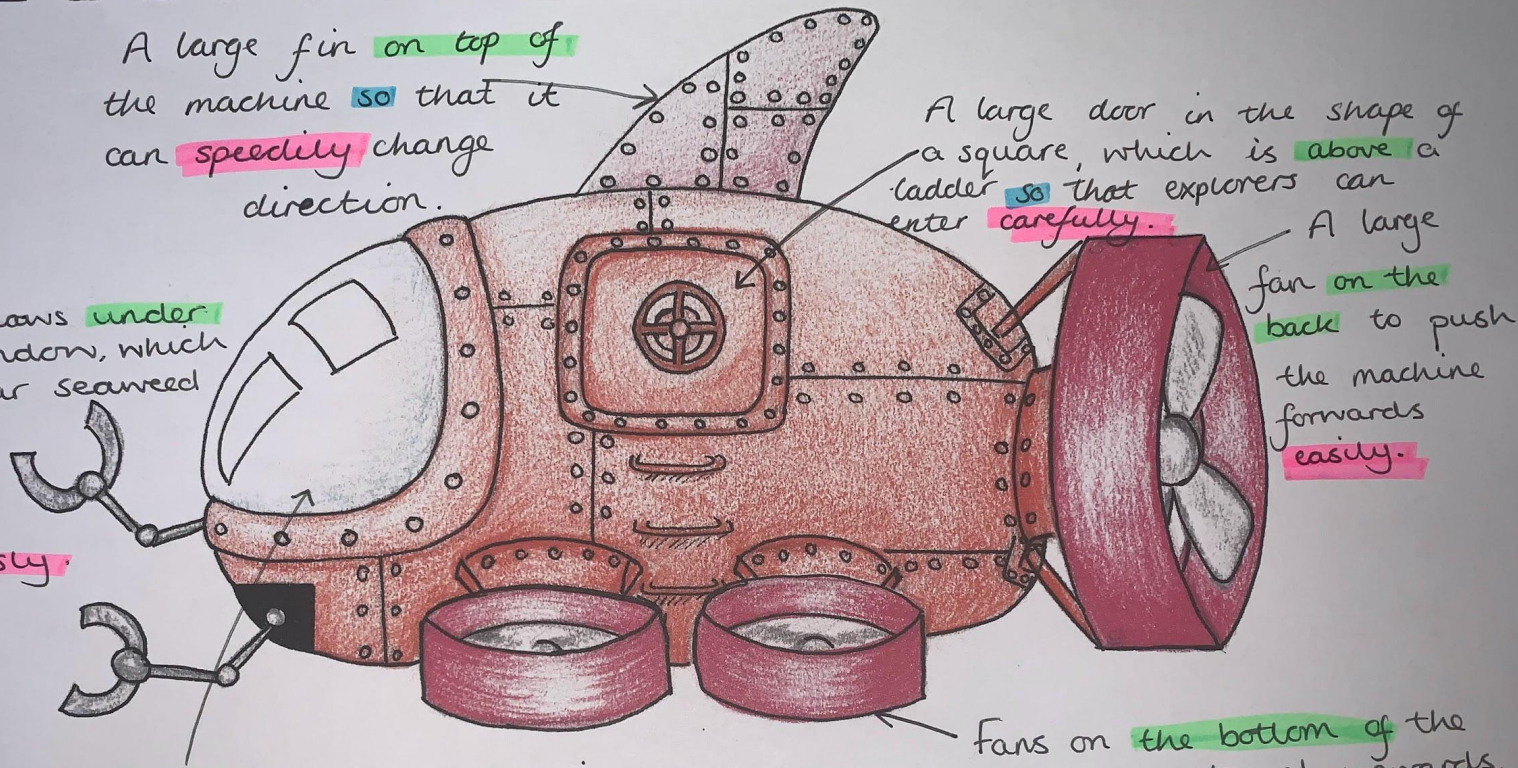
Prepositions

A large fin on top of the machine so that it can speedily change direction.

A large door in the shape of a square, which is above a ladder so that explorers can enter carefully.

A large fan on the back to push the machine forwards easily.

An indestructible window which wraps around the front of the machine because the explorers need to see everything clearly.

Fans on the bottom of the machine to travel upwards, or they can quickly turn into wheels so it can drive on land.
