# Can I use counterarguments to strengthen an argument?

Rewrite the counterarguments, remember you don't want the counterargument to appear too strong to convince them against your argument.

# Example 1

**Argument** - break times are essential in schools as it gives children a rest from their work.

counterargument - break times waste work time

Rewritten counterargument

**Some people might suggest** that break times waste work time, it is true that by having break times less time is spent in the classroom. **However**, children will not miss out on learning as after a break they will be able to concentrate better in class. **This will actually** mean they are able to learn more.

# Example 2

**Argument** - homework is an essential activity as it allows children to recap on what they have learnt in school.

**counterargument** – children need to get at least one hour of physical activity each day which they won't be able to get if they are doing homework.

## **Rewritten counterargument**

**It could be argued** that children must have enough time to do an hour of physical activity each day, it is essential for their health. **However**, they are only at school for six hours a day. If you discount sleep time they still have about seven hours left, surely they could fit some physical activity in this time, couldn't they?
