What is a preposition?

A **preposition** is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else.

For example:

He found the cat underneath the sofa.

'Underneath' is the preposition in this sentence as it shows where the cat was in relation to the sofa.



What is a preposition?

A **preposition** is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else.

For example:

She peered through the telescope to see the stars.

'Through' is the preposition in this sentence as it shows where the girl is in relation to the telescope.
