

What are the difference between the UK and India?


- India is 13 times larger than the UK.
- India has a population of over 1.3 billions, that is over 1.2 billion more than the UK which has a population of approximately 66 million.
- The life expectancy of males in the UK is 79.2 years and in India it is 64.7 years. For females in the UK is 82.9 years and in India it is 68.2 years.





What are the differences between the UK and India?

- India's highest point is the Kanchenjunga mountain at 8586m which is 7242m higher than the UK highest point which is Ben Nevis at 1344m.
- India's longest river is the Ganges at 2525km which is 2171km longer than the UK's longest river which is the River Severn at 354km.
- The temperature in India on average is 10 degrees Celsius hotter than the UK.
