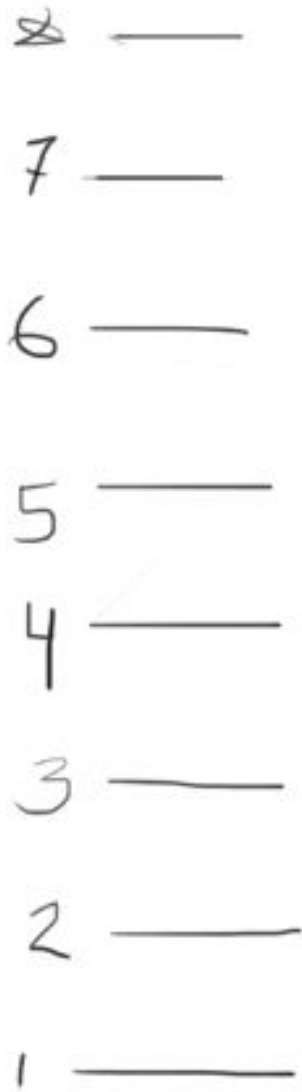


We're going to be developing the skills we learned during our artist's model sketches to draw this person.

- Remember that we're drawing to **proportion**, which means that we need to make sure that we're drawing each part of the body in the correct size.
- We're only going to be sketching the **outline** of this image today, so we don't need to worry about depth or shading just yet. We want to make sure that our proportions are correct.



Split your paper like this to practise drawing the parts of the body proportionately before drawing your full outline.



We also need to remember that to maintain correct proportions, the human body should be around seven - eight heads high.

We will be using 7 sections (eight lines) as a guide.

Tasks

- Draw the outline of this person
- Draw the outline of this person, considering how you can also add the outline of their clothes and hair
- Draw the outline of this person and their clothes. Attempt to include the fingers and toes
