



MONKWICK JUNIOR SCHOOL – ADMISSION APPEALS

NEW INTAKE ADMISSION APPLICATIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2022

If you do not receive an offer of a place at your highest preference school, you can appeal against the decision.

- Appeals should be submitted online to the Statutory Appeals Team using the Local Authority website: <u>https://www.essex.gov.uk/after-your-school-offer/appeals</u>
- If you are unable to submit an appeal online, please send the appeal form, which can be downloaded from the LA's website or obtained at Appendix A, directly to:

- For applications made in the normal admissions round, appeals must be heard within 40 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals.
- For late applications, appeals should be heard within 40 school days from the deadline for lodging appeals where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.

The relevant appeal dates for 2022 are:

19 April 2022	The national offer day for infant, junior and primary school places for September 2022
18 May 2022	The latest date to lodge an appeal against a refusal of a place if you want it heard before the end of the summer term
7 June to 20 July 2022	Appeals heard for those submitted by the deadline and where possible, for late appeals (last day of term: 22 July 2022) by the Local Authority Statutory Appeals Panel
31 August 2022	Waiting list maintained by the Local Authority and thereafter by the school
September 2022 onwards	Any appeals not heard before 22 July 2022

After the appeal hearing you will receive a decision letter within five school days of the hearing wherever possible.





IN-YEAR ADMISSIONS FROM 1 APRIL 2022

If your application for a place has been refused, you have the right to appeal. For most schools in Essex you can appeal online via the Local Authority's website: <u>https://www.essex.gov.uk/after-your-school-offer/appeals</u> You can also download an appeal form from the Local Authority's website or complete and return the appeal form at Appendix A to the Local Authority Statutory Appeals Team.

You will be given a deadline for lodging the appeal which allows at least 20 school days from the date of notification that your application was unsuccessful to prepare and lodge your appeal. The completed appeal form should be sent to: Clerk of the Appeal Panel, PO Box 11, Chelmsford, Essex, CM1 1LX.

On receipt of the appeal form an appeal hearing must be arranged within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged. You will receive at least 10 school days' notice of the date of the appeal hearing. You will be given a reasonable deadline to submit additional evidence in order that the clerk can send the appeal papers to all parties.

After the appeal hearing you will receive a decision letter within five school days of the hearing wherever possible.

APPEAL HEARINGS

On 24 April 2020, the Government released guidelines for schools to follow with regards to the hearing of admission appeals during the pandemic. On 30 September 2021, those guidelines were extended by the government to be in place until 30 September 2022. These amendments permit appeals lodged by parents/carers in 2022, in relation to refusal of a place at Monkwick Junior School, to be held by telephone, video conference or through a paper-based appeal where all parties can make representations in writing.

CHANGES TO APPEAL DEADLINES

The new regulations provide for amendments to deadlines as follows: will ensure that appellants will be given:

- at least 14 calendar days' written notice of an appeal hearing (although appellants can waive their right to this)¹
- Hearings must be held as soon as reasonably practicable.
- Decision letters should be sent within seven calendar days of the hearing, wherever possible.²
