1a. Example answer: The rugby match had to be postponed because the pitch was waterlogged.

2a. Example answer: Allie ran away from the road because he was scared of the traffic.

3a. She is not correct; the subordinate clause is Due to the weather because it does not make sense on its own.

1b. Example answer: Despite the cold, Jacob still wanted to play in the garden.

2b. Example answer: The party was a great success, even though it was a rush to prepare.

3b. He is not correct; the subordinate clause is because the teacher was unwell because it does not make sense on its own.
